- Academic record, particularly in science – related courses.
- Laboratory experience
- Career goals and stated interest in biomedical research, including why you would like to participate in the program.



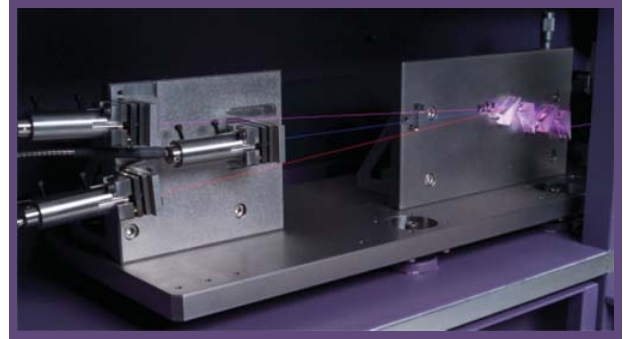
- ✚ \$3,000 stipend

- Two letters of recommendation
- Curriculum Vitae (CV) is optional
